

# **Seeking the Right Recognition**

**Date:** Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> July **Speaker:** Jeff Stamps

Key Verses: Matthew 6:1-8

### **Talk Summary:**

• In our passage today Jesus is asking the uncomfortable question, whose approval are you living for? Whose recognition are you seeking?

- Each of the three sections have a similar structure so you could summarise our passage like this:
  - When you do something good, do not be like the hypocrites, who love to be seen by others.
     Truly I tell you, they have received their reward in full. <sup>6</sup> But when you do something good, do it in secret. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.
- Darrell Johnson, says that in this passage Jesus reveals 3 truths about life:
  - 1. We are all actors in a great drama the invitation is to find our role in God's drama, rather than playing at being someone we aren't.
  - 2. We are always performing before a live audience Which audience are you going to perform for, God or others?
  - 3. We will get the reward we seek Who's recognition are you seeking?
- Application: I want to live for God's recognition. What do I do?
  - In the passage Jesus' practical solution is to practice doing good things in secret. So, this
    next week do something good, kind, generous, and don't tell anyone. Reflect on the
    experience with God and see what you learn about yourself and God and make a habit of
    this.

#### Worship

Worship is not just singing, it is thanking God for who he is and what he has done and is lived out through a life of trusting obedience. Discussing this together is an act of worship.

- 1. Was there anything in this talk (or passage) that you found challenging or that stood out to you?
- 2. How do you feel about the idea that God is always watching?
- 3. Are there any other ways that you can think of to increase your awareness of God's recognition of you and reduce your desire for the recognition of others?
