

Pentecost Sunday

Key Verses: Acts 2:1-47

Talk Summary:

1. The Holy Spirit was poured out

- Pentecost was the fulfilment of Old Testament prophecy (v16) (Joel 2:28-29, 1 Samuel 10:6 and more)
- The Spirt transformed Pete
- The spirit still transforms lives today. People find faith, people are healed, and people are empowered for service.

2. The Gospel was preached

- As happens consistently in scripture, experience was followed by explanation
- Peters message was all about Jesus, the gospel is all about Jesus:
- Jesus' life (v22) his life of love and power
- Jesus' death (v23) Peter points out their sin, he rebukes them and points to Gods mercy
- Jesus' resurrection (v24) Our liberation (freedom) is only possible because of Jesus victory
- Jesus' Kingship (v36) The Gospel is the good news of the kingdom of God, of Jesus rule and reign
- From his position as Lord, Christ, King, Jesus sends the Holy Spirit (v33)

3. The Church was born:

- The church is formed by the coming of The Spirit and the preaching of the gospel.
- Repent-believe-be baptised –be filled with the Holy Spirit (v38)
- People joined community and lived a new radical lifestyle (v41-47)
- To follow Jesus and join the church was a risky decision then and it is now.
- But the rewards and repercussions are worth it (Philippians 1:21)
- To believe and belong is such a relief

- The community was organised around love for one another and God not authority or revolution It's a great time to respond to Peter's message:
 - Come to Jesus
 - Be filled with the Holy Spirit

• Spend some time thanking God for the gift of the Holy Spirit and reflecting on all Holy Spirit does for us.

Word

- In what ways do we see Peter transformed by the Holy Spirit? (read Luke 22:54-62 and compare it to today's passage) How does this give us hope for ourselves?
- Do we sometimes forget that the good news we have is all about Jesus? How can we keep our message Jesus focused?
- What adventures of faith is God inviting you into as we step out in the spirits power, to preach the gospel and invite people into community.
